What is SEAC? It's the Stafford Special Education Advisory Committee. The Stafford County Special Education Advisory Committee (SEAC) is organized and functions in accordance with the mandate in the Regulations Governing Special Education Programs in Virginia, as defined by the Virginia Department of Education (VDOE). The committee's functions include the following:

- Advise the local school division of needs in the education of children with disabilities
- Participate in the development of priorities and strategies for meeting the identified needs of children with disabilities
- Submit periodic reports and recommendations regarding the education of children with disabilities to the division superintendent for transmission to the school board,
- Assist the local school division in interpreting plans to the community for meeting the needs of children with disabilities for educational services
- Review policies and procedures for the provision of special education and related services prior to submission to the school board
- Participate in the review of the local school division's annual plan

Attending a SEAC is a great way to learn what parents like you are working on in Stafford County Public Schools. If you want to make a difference and work with like-minded parents and community members on important issues affecting students with disabilities come to a meeting or even consider joining the committee. **The next meeting is November 13 at 7:00pm.** Like the SEAC Facebook page at Stafford County Public Schools Special Education Advisory Committee for updates.

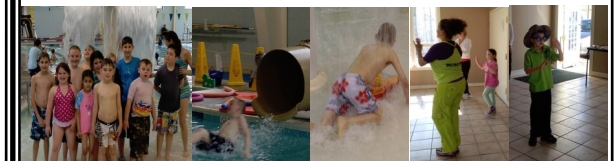
